Independent auditors' report on review of condensed consolidated interim financial information

Introduction

We have reviewed the accompanying condensed consolidated interim financial position of Nafais Holding Company K.S.C. (Closed) ("the Company"), and its subsidiaries (together referred to as "the Group") as at 30 September 2009, and the related condensed consolidated interim statements of income, comprehensive income, changes in equity and cash flows for three month period then ended.

Management is responsible for the preparation and presentation of this condensed consolidated interim financial information in accordance with IAS 34, 'Interim Financial Reporting', Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on this condensed consolidated interim financial information based on our review. We did not review the interim financial information of certain subsidiaries, whose total assets of KD 38,654,329 amounted to 29% of total assets of the Group as at 30 September 2009 and whose total revenues of KD 3,582,311 amounted to 80 % of total revenues of the Group for the three month period ended 30 September 2009. We also did not review the interim financial information of an associate, of which the Group's share of net assets of KD 16,173,161 amounted to 12% of total assets of the Group as at 30 September 2009 and of which the Group's share of loss of KD 166,096 amounted to 4 % of total revenues of the Group for the three month period ended 30 September 2009. The interim financial information of these subsidiaries and associate were reviewed by other auditors whose reports have been furnished to us, and our conclusion, insofar as it relates to the amounts included for these subsidiaries and associate are based solely on the reports of other auditors.

Scope of Review

We conducted our review in accordance with International Standard on Review Engagements 2410, "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity". A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with International Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Based on our review and the review reports of other auditors, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying condensed consolidated interim financial information is not prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with IAS 34, 'Interim Financial Reporting'.

Emphasis of Matter

Without qualifying our conclusion, we draw attention to Note 2 to the condensed consolidated interim financial information, where material uncertainty about the Group's ability to continue as going concern has been summarized.

Report on other legal and regulatory requirements

Furthermore, based on our review, the condensed consolidated interim financial information is in agreement with the books of account of the Company. We further report that nothing has come to our attention indicating any contravention during the three month period ended 30 September 2009, of the Kuwait Commercial Companies Law of 1960, as amended, or of the Company's articles and memorandum of association, which might have materially affected the Company's activities or its consolidated financial position.

2. Fundamental accounting principle

Although the Group has incurred a loss of KD 2,450,961 for the three month period ended 30 September 2009 (30 September 2008: loss of KD 12,075,425) and its current liabilities exceeded current assets by KD 56,847,167 as at 30 September 2009 (30 June 2009: KD 38,540,675 and 30 September 2008: KD 24,991,175), the condensed consolidated interim financial information have been prepared on a going concern basis.

The ability of the Group to continue as a going concern is dependent on the availability of continued support from the financial institutions and shareholders and the ability of the Group to improve profitability and cash flows. The management is in the process of negotiating the terms of the settlement of its short term facilities with financial institutions whereby these short term facilities will be converted into medium and long term facilities. The management is confident that they will be able to renegotiate the terms of these facilities.

If the Group is unable to continue its operational existence for the foreseeable future, it may be unable to discharge its liabilities in the normal course of business. Accordingly, adjustments may have to be made to reflect the situation that assets may need to be realized other than in normal course of business and at amounts which could differ significantly from the amounts at which they are currently recorded in the condensed consolidated interim financial position. In addition, the Group may have to reclassify non-current assets and liabilities as current assets and liabilities respectively. No such adjustments have been made to this condensed consolidated interim financial information.

3. Basis of preparation

a) Statement of compliance

The condensed consolidated interim financial information has been prepared in accordance with International Accounting Standard No. 34, *Interim Financial Reporting* and the Kuwait Stock Exchange instructions No. 2 of 1998.

The condensed consolidated interim financial information does not include all of the information and footnotes required for complete financial statements prepared in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRSs).

In the opinion of management, all adjustments considered necessary for a fair presentation have been included.

The operating results for the three months ended 30 September 2009 are not necessarily indicative of the results that may be expected for the period ending 31 December 2010.

The condensed consolidated interim financial information has been prepared using the same accounting policies and methods of computation as compared with the Group's latest audited consolidated financial statements for the year ended 30 June 2009, except described in note 4.

The preparation of condensed consolidated interim financial information requires management to make judgments, estimates and assumptions that affect the application of accounting policies and the reported amounts of assets and liabilities, income and expenses. Actual results may differ from these estimates.

The significant judgments made by the management in applying the accounting policies were the same as those applied to consolidated financial statements for the year ended 30 June 2009.

4. Significant accounting policies

a) Presentation of financial statements

The Group applies revised IAS 1 Presentation of Financial Statements (2007), which became effective as of 1 July 2009. As a result, the Group presents in the condensed consolidated interim statement of changes in equity all owner changes in equity, whereas all non-owner changes in equity are presented in the condensed consolidated interim statement of comprehensive income. This presentation has been applied in this condensed consolidated interim financial information as of and for the three months period ended 30 September 2009.

Comparative information has been re-presented to be in conformity with the revised standard. Since the change in accounting policy only impacts presentation aspects, there is no impact on loss per share.

b) Determination and presentation of operating segments

As of 1 July 2009, the Group determines and presents operating segments based on the information that internally is provided to the Executive Committee, who is the Group's operating decision maker. This change is due to the adoption of IFRS 8 *Operating Segments*. Previously operating segments were determined and presented in accordance with IAS 14 *Segment Reporting*.

Comparative segment information has been re-presented in conformity with the transitional requirements of IFRS 8. Since the change in accounting policy only impacts presentation and disclosure aspects, there is no impact on loss per share.

An operating segment is a component of the Group that engages in business activities from which it may earn revenues and incur expenses, including revenues and expenses that relate to transactions with any of the Group's other components. An operating segment's operating results are viewed regularly by the Executive Committee to make decision about resources to be allocated to the segment and assess its performance, and for which discrete financial information is available.

Segment results that are reported to Executive Committee include items directly attributable to a segment as well as those that can be allocated on a reasonable basis. Unallocated items comprise mainly corporate assets (primarily the Parent Company), and the Parent Company's expenses, assets and liabilities.

c) Reclassification to investment property

During the period, the Group has adopted amendments in IAS 40 *Investment Property*. The amendment requires property under construction or development for future use as an investment property, to be classified as investment property.

Since the Group follows 'fair value model' property under construction or development should be fair valued at each reporting date. If fair value cannot be reliably determined, property under construction or development will be measured at cost until such time as fair value can be determined or construction is complete.

As a result of this amendment, the Group has reclassified property under development as at 30 June 2009 to investment property with effect from 1 July 2009.
